In the above-referenced case, the Inspector General's Office ("IGO") recommended that "[u]nless and until the residency ordinance is amended," the Department of Human Resources ("DHR") and the Mayor's Office "cease granting waivers for City employees."

DHR will no longer grant residency waivers. If the residency ordinance is amended such that waivers are permitted, DHR will make any necessary changes to the Personnel Rules and any other relevant policies and procedures and ensure that all DHR employees and departmental HR Liaisons are properly trained.
